2022 Annual Report

N THIS THIRD YEAR of the pandemic, the numbers of people seeking DSC services rose to pre-pandemic levels, over 2300. Needs for connection building through Restorative Practices, facilitation of difficult organizational issues brought on by the changing work-place, and mediation between neighbors, co-workers, and family members were handled virtually and in-person. Schools managing stressed students and parents reached out, and we worked in the Person, Chatham, Orange, Durham, and Harnett systems. As court opened back up, we met clients in district court and worked with court officials to offer Restorative Justice for appropriate cases.

DSC focuses locally but is involved in the national conversation about how to have safe and respectful conversations about difficult issues. Our Leadership Dialogues Program helps build these skills.
